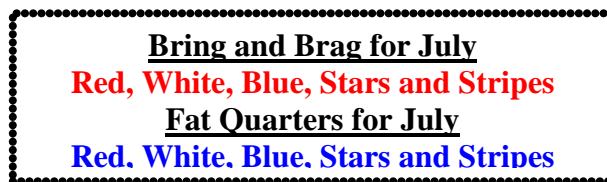

**June Potluck Favorite** by Beverly Sowells

***SCALLOPED POTATO CASSEROLE***

- 2 to 3 large potatoes, peel and boil potatoes until almost done, then slice
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup or (cream of mushroom with roasted garlic)
- 1 can water
- 1/2 onion, sliced
- 1/2 cup Monterey Jack cheese
- 1/2 cup cheddar cheese
- 3 tablespoons butter

Layer potatoes, onions and cheese in greased casserole dish until desired portion. Blend together soup and water, pour over top of potatoes, dot with butter and sprinkle with more cheese. Bake at 325 degrees for 1-1/2 hours or until potatoes are tender

**Block of the Month** by Elsie Kessinger (707/422-3987)

**Red, White & Blue Log Cabin**

Unfinished 12-1/2" Finished 12"

Red - 1(one) 2 1/2" square and 1(one) 7" square

White on White - 5 assorted prints

Blue - 5 assorted prints.

**Cut as follows:**

White: 1 - 1 1/2 " x 2 1/2"

Blue **and** White 1 each of the following:

1 1/2" x 3 1/2"; 1 1/2" x 8 1/2";

1 1/2" x 4 1/2"; 1 1/2" x 9 1/2";

1 1/2" x 5 1/2"; 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

1 1/2" x 6 1/2"; 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"

1 1/2" x 7 1/2";

**Blue: 1 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"**

**Join in the following order:**

Turn block 90 degrees counter clockwise after each addition.

Begin with the red 2 1/2" square.

Add:

1 1/2" x 2 1/2" white;

3 1/2" white; 3 1/2" blue;

4 1/2" blue; 4 1/2" white;

5 1/2" white; 5 1/2" blue;

6 1/2" blue; 6 1/2" white;

7 1/2" white; 7 1/2" blue;

8 1/2" blue; 8 1/2" white;

9 1/2" white; 9 1/2" blue;

10 1/2" blue; 10 1/2" white;

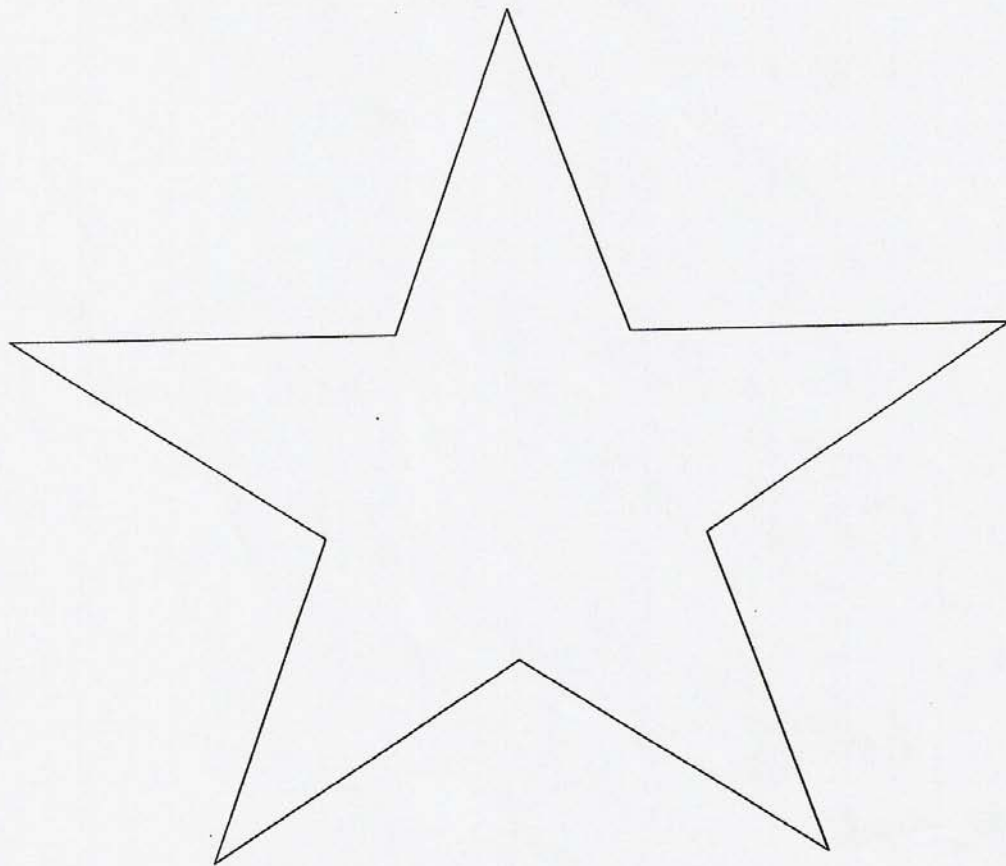
11 1/2" white; 11 1/2" blue;

12 1/2" blue.

Trace star onto red 7" square. Cut out allowing 1/4" seam if hand appliquéing.

Appliqué star to center of block.

Remember to sign your completed block.
