April: FAT QUARTER - Easter egg Fabric  
BRING&BRAG – springtime

May: FAT QUARTER – Flowers (any color)

June: FAT QUARTER – Blues, solid/reads like solid  
BRING&BRAG - Heritage quilts (must be 25 years old)

**How to Use the Library by Wilma Powell** (707/374-4034)

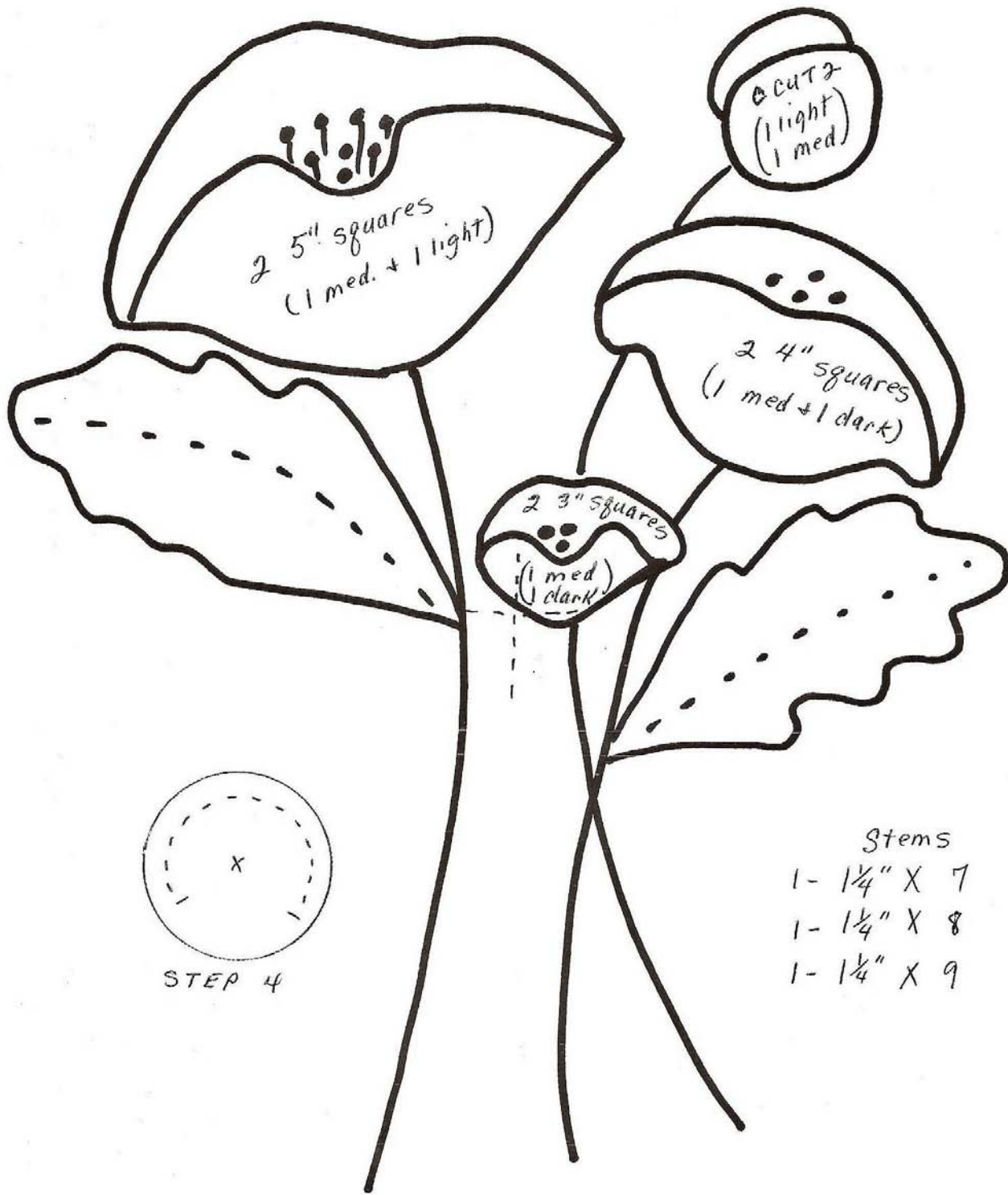
When checking a book out, take the card from the file with the # and name of the book. Put your name, tel. # and date checked out on the card. Then place it in the "Books Out" area of the box. When returned (after one month or sooner) write the date returned and replace the card in numerical order in the file box.

**Block of the Month** by Elsie Kessinger (707/422-3987)**Dimensional Poppy** - Due May 4<sup>th</sup>

Materials:

**Background:** 13" square tan or off white; Leaves: bud, stems – scraps of green. **Flowers** scraps of yellow/orange. Black & green embroidery floss.

- Trace pattern onto background fabric.
- Appliqué leaves, stems and bud using your favorite method.
- Large flower – cut two 5" squares; one each light and medium fabrics.  
Medium flower – cut two 4" squares; one each medium and dark fabrics.  
Small flower – cut two 3" squares; one each medium and dark fabrics.
- Large flower – put 5" squares right sides together. Draw 4½" circle on lightest circle. Sew on this line by machine or hand sew. Trim. Cut small hole in center of lightest side only. Turn right side out. Press. Draw line on lightest side ½" from pressed edge about 2/3" ways around. Hand gather on line and fold to fit pattern. Sew to background fabric. Repeat for medium and small flowers using 3½" circle for medium flower and 2½" circle for small flower.
- Embroider French knots with black floss and lines on leaves with green.
